The Ministry of Education supported EarlyOn Centre at Anishnawbe Mushkiki Community Health and Wellness is recruiting a Registered Early Childhood Educator, working with the Renewed Early Years and Child Care Policy Framework.

As the Early Childhood Educator, you will work under the guidance and direction of the Manager of Community Services at Anishnawbe Mushkiki.

Responsibilities

- The RECE will plan, develop, and deliver programming that will build responsive adult-child relationships and encourage exploration, play and inquiry, supported by How Does Learning Happen? Ontario's Pedagogy for the Early Years.
- Making connections and responding to a parent/caregiver concern about their child's development through conversations and observations which can be supported by validated tools and resources, for example developmental surveillance, Nipissing Distinct Developmental Screen (NDDS) and in some cases this may result in supporting parents/caregivers to seek additional support from primary care or other regulated health professionals
- Sharing information and facilitating connections of specialized community services (such as children rehabilitation services), coordinated service planning, public health, education, child care as appropriate
- The ECE will develop programs and ensure that the programs accessed by Indigenous children and families are culturally responsive programs.
- Provides participants with an evaluation to ensure there is continuous quality improvement of all early years delivered programs, as well as working with community partners to ensure program delivery is of high quality.

- Diploma in Early Childhood Education, registered as an Early Childhood Educator
- Minimum three years' related work experience
- Through understanding of the guiding principles of child and family centered care
- Experience with using the Pedagogical Framework, How Does Learning Happen?
- Use of an automobile, valid driver's license and appropriate insurance are required
- Tuberculin (TB) Skin Test, satisfactory Criminal Record Check including Vulnerable Sector Screening Check
- Superior organizational and time management skills
- Demonstrated ability to work effectively as a team member in a Interprofessional team environment
