RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist with delivering programming that will build responsive adult-child relationships and encourage exploration, play and inquiry, supported by How Does Learning Happen?, Ontario's Pedagogy for the Early Years.
- Make connections and responding to a parent/caregiver concern about their child's development through conversations and observations which can be supported by validated

tools and resources, and may result in supporting parents/caregivers to seek additional support from primary care or other regulated health professionals.

- Share information and facilitate connections of specialized community services (such as children rehabilitation services), coordinated service planning, public health, education, childcare as appropriate.
- Provide participants with an evaluation to ensure there is continuous quality improvement of all early years delivered programs, as well as working with community partners to ensure program delivery is of high quality.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Full-time College or University student currently enrolled and returning to a post-secondary program in Early Childhood Education or related field.
- Use of an automobile, valid driver's license and appropriate insurance are preferred but not required.
- Tuberculin (TB) Skin Test, satisfactory Criminal Record Check including Vulnerable Sector Screening Check
